FUN FACTS

HERE ARE SOME FUN FISH FACTS...

- There are over 25,000 known species of fish.
- All fish have backbones.
- All fish are cold-blooded (their blood and body temperature changes as the water temperature changes).
- Electric eels produce enough energy in one shock to light up every room in your house.
- A jellyfish is 95% water.
- Fish don't have ears. They hear or feel vibrations along the lateral line of their bodies.
- Fish can get seasick if they are stored aboard a rolling ship or shaken enough in a pail of water. One scientific experiment created waves in a fish bowl that resulted in seasick goldfish.

This week's exploration had a focus on introductions. Just as we introduced you to many different fish, your assignments this week are designed to help you make introductions to some new people around you.

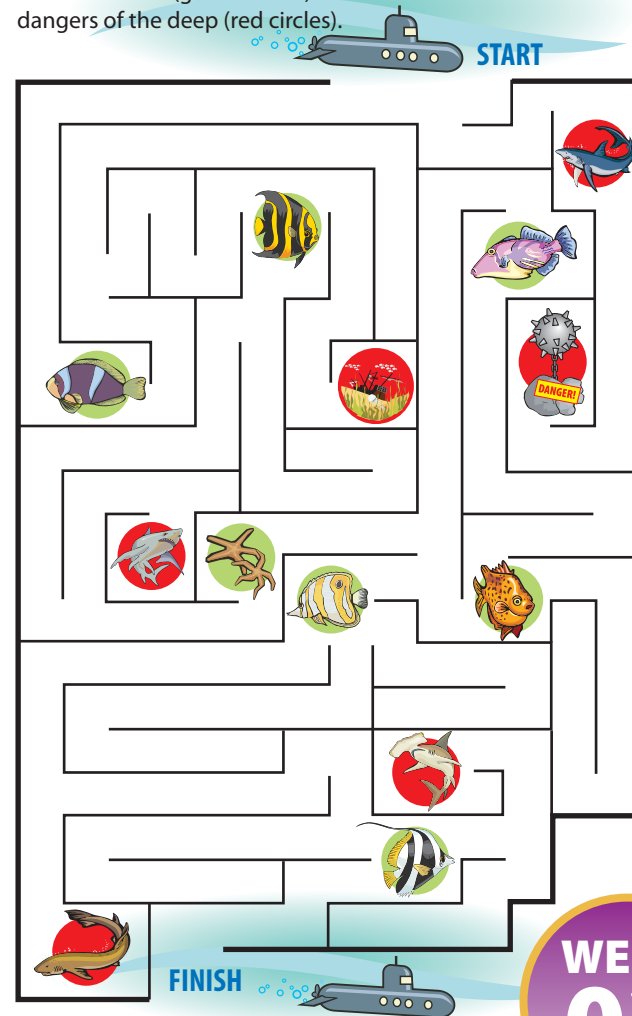

Find all the fish (green circles) in the reef and avoid the dangers of the deep (red circles).



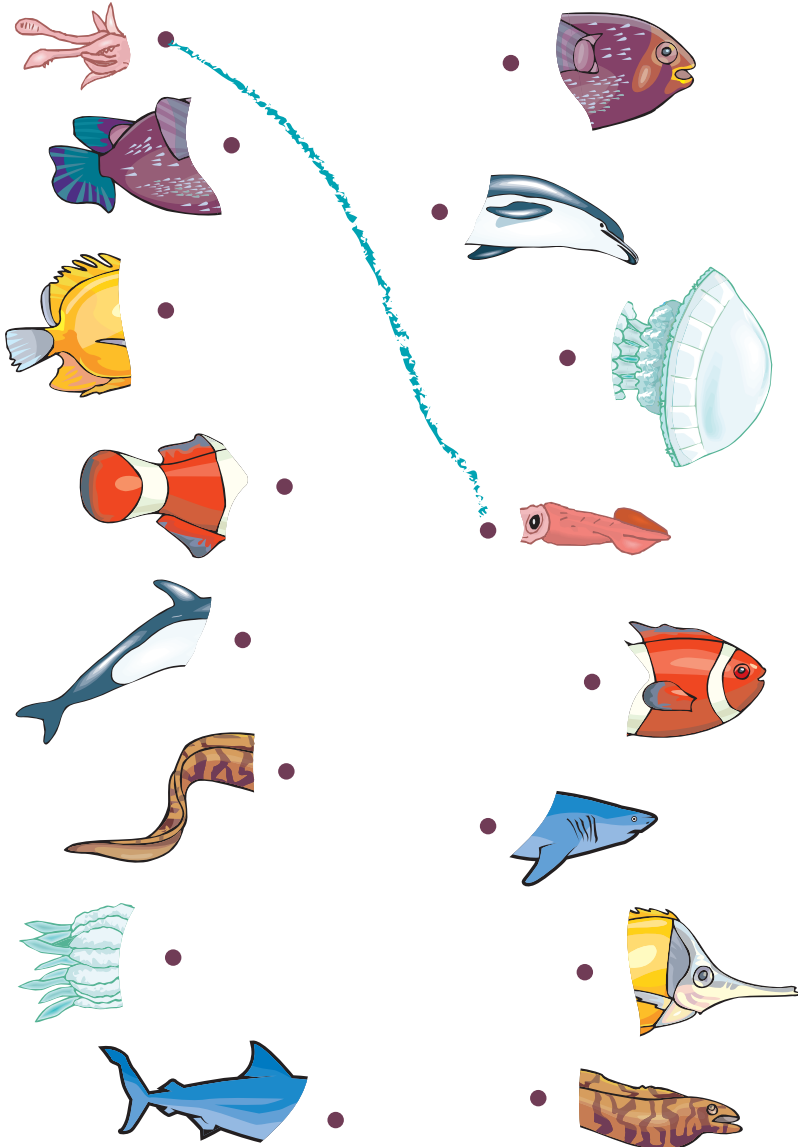
